

DUI No-Refusal Search Warrant Program / LEG068R:

Every year, impaired drivers cause thousands of traffic deaths and injuries throughout the United States. Prosecutors and law enforcement officers hold the key to winning many D.U.I. cases with a very simple tool – the D.U.I. search warrant.

Designed for law enforcement officers and prosecutors alike, this half-day, 3 hour program will provide instruction and discussion on how to design a no-refusal program that fits different jurisdictions. Additionally, participants will be provided with current case law relevant to the search warrant process, with particular focus placed on repeat offenders.

Topics to be addressed include:

- The history and success of the Adams County (Illinois) D.U.I. Search Warrant Program
- Implementing a No-Refusal program in your jurisdiction
- Who should be on the team and what challenges to expect
- The mechanics of obtaining manual and electronic D.U.I. search warrants
- Relevant case law on D.U.I. search warrants
- Options when D.U.I. offenders persist in refusing after search warrants are obtained

Please note: Departments are encouraged to invite local prosecutors and State's Attorney personnel to join them in attending this program.

In July of 2016, Jennifer was named National Prosecutor of the Year in recognition of her work in developing this program and her willingness to share it with other prosecutors and law enforcement agencies.
