

The Village of Campton Hills Police and Fire Commission are currently accepting applications for full-time lateral transfer police officers. In order to qualify, all applicants must have previously served for a minimum of five years as a full-time sworn police officer of a municipal, county, university or state law enforcement agency. Applicants must possess a current certification by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board and have not been separated from their last law enforcement agency within the state for more than 24 months. The salary range for the position is \$48,223-\$67,368.

In addition, all candidates must meet the following requirements:

- Confirm status as a certified Illinois police officer per the Illinois Police Training Act
- Be a United States citizen
- Education-must possess a high school diploma or G.E.D. certificate
- Possess a valid driver's license
- Reside within a 25-mile radius of the Campton Hills Village Hall
- Every applicant must be of good moral character, of temperate habits, of sound health and must be physically and mentally able to perform the duties of the position of police officer.
- Be free of any felony convictions, or misdemeanor criminal convictions as specified in 65 ILCS 5-10-1-7(C) of the Illinois Revised Statutes
- Must be able to furnish upon request a copy of the following, to the extent applicable:  
a resume; professional licenses; training certificates, documents confirming work experience; birth certificate, high school diploma or G.E.D. certificate; transcripts of higher learning; naval or military service board and discharge papers (DD-214/Copy 4); employee evaluations; and any other employment related material as requested or required

Lateral entry applicants must provide documentation to show their previous responsibilities and duties were similar to those of a police officer in the Village of Campton Hills. This will be accomplished through a combination of prior employer evaluations, records of past and current assignments and training certificates. Unless specifically waived by the Commission for a specific applicant, screening of entry applicants will include:

- Background investigation
- Polygraph exam
- Psychological exam
- Medical Exam
- Oral Interview
