The Town of Cortland is currently accepting applications for Part-time Police Officer.

The application process is ongoing.

Starting salary is \$21.63/hour to increase to \$22.63/hour May 1.

Cortland is located in Central DeKalb County and borders the City of DeKalb on the west and Sycamore to the north. Cortland population per last census is 4270 and the Police Department has 6 full time officers.

This position encompasses the principles of law enforcement: Keeping the peace, enforcing regulatory law, apprehending law breakers and educating the public. Cortland also has 3 special events throughout the year where all officers must be prepared to work.

This position may lead to full time employment based on seniority (date of hire).

**Qualifications:**

- United States citizen.
- 21 years of age.
- Valid D.L.
- Must be full time certified by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board and currently serving as a full time officer or separated in good standing as a full time officer.
- Must participate in and complete all stages of the hiring process which may include oral interview(s), background investigation, psychological and fit for duty test to include a drug screen.
- No criminal record.
- Part-time officers work 8 hour shifts and are expected to be available for a minimum of four shifts per month. All applicants must be available to work midnights, weekends and holidays if needed.
