Seeking Applicants for Part-Time Police Officers

The Village of East Hazel Crest is currently accepting applications from qualified individuals for the position of Part-Time Police Officer. Part-Time Police Officers are responsible for regular police duties plus specialized assignments including but not limited to:

- Enforcing traffic, criminal and municipal ordinance laws
- Providing patrol duties
- Responding to emergency and non-emergency situations
- Articulating police situations in written reports
- Working varied shifts and special assignments
- Minimum shifts per month to be determined before hire.

Minimum qualifications include:

- 21 years of age
- Must be a certified Police Officer either full or part-time for the State of Illinois or another state in which the training is accepted by the Illinois State Training Board
- U.S. Citizen
- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Valid FOID card
- Good moral character
- Must be able to physically perform the duties of a police officer
- No felony or disqualifying misdemeanor convictions including orders of protection

All qualified applicants will be required to:

- Pass an oral interview
- Pass a comprehensive background check
- Pass a pre-employment psychological exam
- Pass a physical exam by a physician
- Pass a drug screen
- Pass a field training program prior to being certified for solo patrol

Generally, part-time Officers in good standing are considered first for available full-time positions when the position becomes available.

Applications are available for pick-up at the East Hazel Crest Police Department 24 hours a day. Applications will be accepted until the desired positions are filled.

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
