Position Summary:

This part-time police position involves a variety of traditional policing duties, along with providing police services for community events. This part-time position does not advance to a full-time police officer position; there is a separate testing process for full-time police officers.

Qualifications:

- *United States citizen
- *Must be 21 years of age or older
- *High School Diploma
- *Must be currently certified with a Law Enforcement Basic Training Course by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board
- *Must be currently serving as a sworn police officer or have served as a sworn officer in Illinois within the last 18 months
- *Valid driver's license
- *Must not have been convicted of a felony or certain misdemeanors, as defined by the statute
- *Must participate in and complete all stages of the hiring process which may include, but not be limited to: oral interview, extensive background investigation, polygraph and post offer psychological, physical exam, and drug screen
- *Must reside within forty (40) miles of the Elburn Police facility
