To Qualify You Must:

- ✓ Be a currently sworn Illinois municipal police officer, State Trooper, or a county sheriff's deputy who possesses a FULL TIME State of Illinois law enforcement certification from the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board, or recently separated/retired in good standing, with a MINIMUM OF 10 YEARS' EXPERIENCE AS A FULL TIME Police Officer. (PART TIME certification or employment as any type of correctional officer other than that, specified above, DOES NOT meet this requirement.)
- ✓ Be a United States Citizen of good moral character, along with a good mental and physical condition.
- ✓ Possess a Valid Driver's License and FOID card
- ✓ If hired, agree to comply with all requirements of the position and have the ability to pass all future training/examination requirements.
- ✓ Be able to work 8 hour shifts, primarily on midnight, but not exclusively, along with weekdays, and weekends. Expected to submit your availability to work 8 shifts per 28 day schedule for our flexibility for scheduling purposes, but you are only expected to work a minimum of 3 shifts per schedule. (Up to possibly 999 hours per year if shifts are available.) Holidays are paid at time and a half. You are also required to submit availability to work at least half of the paid holidays.

If selected to move forward in the employment process, you will have to:
Pass an oral interview, a thorough background investigation, including possible credit check. After acceptance of appointment, pass a pre-employment physical, drug screening, and possibly a psychological evaluation.

Duties:

Traditional police related work, including but not limited to responding to calls for service & emergencies, rendering first aid, enforcing traffic & criminal laws along with local ordinances.
Conduct premise checks, community contact with our merchants & residents, interact with the children by stopping at lemonade stands, play catch in our parks, or shoot some hoops in a driveway, in a very police supportive community.
