

NORTH EAST MULTI-REGIONAL TRAINING (Naperville, IL) POLICE TRAINING SPECIALIST

North East Multi-Regional Training (NEMRT), Mobile Training Unit #3 in Naperville, IL, is seeking a qualified professional for the role of Police Training Specialist. This position's primary focus is evaluating the quality of the certified training being conducted by agencies as mandate in-house training classes. The Police Training Specialist is primarily responsible for: assessing the skill set of the instructor(s); assessing the accuracy of course content; verifying that mandates are being met during instruction; and assessing the suitability of host site locations for various training purposes. Additionally, this position may perform as Safety Officer for training activities involving live fire, Simunitions, or other high-risk events.

The position requires a high degree of organizational and communication skills. Work is performed under general guidelines and is subject to review through periodic verbal and written reports to the Program Manager for Training Evaluation and Safety.

Preferred Qualifications

Two years' attendance at an accredited college or university with major course work in criminal justice, secondary education, or a related field and significant law enforcement experience, particularly patrol and SWAT functions or, any equivalent combination of training, education, and experience which provides the following skills, knowledge, and abilities:

- Understanding of Public Acts 101-0652, 84-674 and 89-170, training mandate guidelines and administrative codes and basic knowledge of in-service training and course preparation
- Instructional experience in law enforcement environment preferred:
 - Firearms/Rifle Instructor and scenario-based training experience
 - Simunitions Safety Officer/Instructor certification or equivalent
 - Trauma response training (minimum of Stop the Bleed)
 - Tactical LE response training; Rapid Deployment, RTF, CQB and building searches

Mandatory Requirements

- Thorough knowledge of contemporary office procedures and systems, Microsoft Office business English, grammar, spelling, mathematics, and the ability to communicate effectively in English in both written and verbal form
- Will require nonstandard work hours (weekends and holidays), in outdoor training areas
- The ability to lift and carry training equipment and other items weighing up to 50 pounds
- Maintain a valid Illinois Firearms Owners Identification Card and Driver's License
